Internship Opportunities with the EYO

Summer music education and administration opportunities available

GADSDEN, AL, April 28, 2019 - - The Etowah Youth Orchestras will have summer internship opportunities available in the fields of music education and arts administration for May through August of 2019. The internships are unpaid, but the EYO will work with college and university administration to provide academic credit when available.

The EYO will accept up to three interns for the summer period, beginning May 15th through August 15th. Days and hours per week are flexible, and the internships can be structured to fit each individual's summer schedule. Interns should plan on working a minimum of two and a maximum of five days per week.

The internships are design to encompass a broad spectrum of music education and administration responsibilities. Education work includes assisting with the EYO's Summer Strings Camp and acceptance and seating auditions. Administrative work will include music library, grant preparation and research, and program operation duties.

The internships are open to students majoring or minoring in any field of music or in arts administration. Students should be currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program in one of these disciplines and should be available to be in Gadsden during normal daily business hours at least two days per week. Some weekend and evening hours may be requested, based on the EYO's summer schedule of activities.

Applications are currently being accepted for the EYO summer internships, and the positions will remain open until filled by qualified candidates. Applications will be reviewed as received.

To apply, please submit a cover letter detailing current and previous music education and/or administration experience and current academic status, along with a current resume and a list of three reference. Applications will be accepted electronically **ONLY** at mikegagliardo@culturalarts.org.
